FAI all entries will fly prelims and semis (6 rounds) top 8 fly 2 round finals. Masters all pilots fly 6 round prelims, top 10 pilots fly 2 round finals. Sportsman, Intermediate, & Advance fly 2 rounds per day for 4 days.
